Dear Ms. Smith,

This report summarizes the results of the April 16, 2021 mercury air monitoring of the Cape May Technical School MAC gym.

Continuous air monitoring conducted near the gym stage over an approximate 4-hour period (10:10 AM to 2:20PM) revealed **average airborne mercury levels at 0.10  $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$**  (range 0.05 - 0.17  $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ ); below the NJ Department of Health guideline of 0.8  $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ . Based upon these findings, no mercury inhalation exposure hazard is suggested.

Thank you for the opportunity to assist you with the evaluation. Our next monthly monitoring will be scheduled for May 2021.
