GENERAL INFORMATION

- This high school summer school program is for students who have failed an existing course in their home school with a grade of sufficient value to indicate the possibility of successful course completion in the summer school program.
- Students are able to take only one high school make-up course during the summer session.
- School will be in session daily, starting Monday, July 12, for a period of nineteen (19) days ending on August 5, 2010. Each session will be three (3) hours, twenty (20) minutes in length, with two, five (5) minute breaks. Classes will begin at 8:30am and end at 11:50 am each day except: Health classes are in session July 12 through July 15 from 8:00am to 11:55 am; and Physical Education classes are in session July 16 through August 5 from 8:30am to 11:40am. Note: all students must leave the campus immediately upon dismissal.
- Students will be graded daily and must earn a final course average of seventy (70) to be recommended for course credit.
- Students that successfully complete a make-up course will be issued both a letter grade and numerical grade. An official high school credit transcript form will also be awarded indicating the completed course and associated credit. Final course grades will be sent to the student's parent/guardian and to the home school guidance department.
- No bus transportation will be provided for summer school. Students themselves and/or parents/guardians will be responsible for transportation to and from the Cape May County Technical School District Campus.
- Students who plan to drive to school will be required to register their vehicle with the Summer School Office at the Technical School prior to the first day of class. A parking permit will be issued.
- The Cape May County Technical School District assumes no responsibility for any loss or damage to any student vehicle or personal possession.

Note: All courses offered are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrollment or staff availability.

COURSE APPROVAL

Before a summer school registration form can be accepted for potential enrollment in any course, the identified student must have approval to take the course of interest from the home school principal or his/her designee. (Please note signature requirement of "home school" official on summer school registration form.) Students must meet home school attendance/academic requirements to attend summer school.

TUITION

A tuition fee of \$325.00 will be charged for each course except Health which will have a tuition fee of \$81.25 and Physical Education which will have a tuition fee of \$243.75. The tuition fee is payable upon submission of the registration form. All fees may be paid by cash, check or money order payable to CMC Tech or by Visa, MasterCard or Discover credit/debit cards. Mail in registration should be paid with check or money order. No tuition fee refunds will be made after the first day of summer school. Note: Any tuition fee refunds that are approved may take up to six (6) weeks to process.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance requirements are set by law. All students must attend class daily for nineteen (19) days completing at least sixty (60) class hours of instruction. Therefore, students are not permitted to have any absences. A bona fide medical excuse, confirmed by a written statement from a doctor, may be considered for one day's absence. In any case, if a student is late more than twice or exceeds one absence (misses more than three (3) hours of classroom instruction), a program withdraw notice will be issued. No absences are permitted in any Health Class.

MEDICAL EXCUSES FOR PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students will not be permitted to enroll in physical education class if he/she has a medical excuse. Any student who receives a medical excuse during the summer session will be governed by the attendance requirements.
