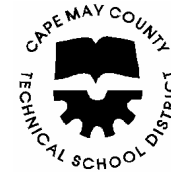
Office Hours: Monday through Friday,

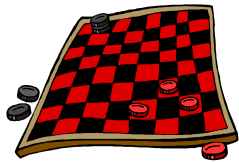
Mail-in registrations will be confirmed after processing. A copy of the registration form will be returned to the applicant as a receipt.

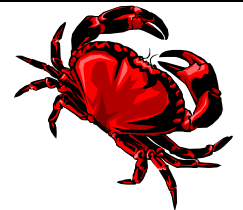

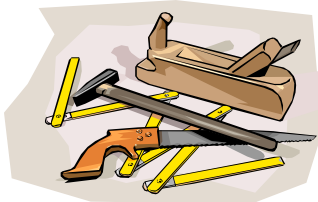

Directions to the Cape May County Technical School

The Cape May County Technical School is located in the Crest Haven Complex, Exit 11 on the Garden State Parkway. The Evening/Continuing Education Office is located in the Tozour 100 Building.

From North:

- Garden State Parkway South to Exit 11 (Stay in left lane as you approach Exit 11). Make a left turn at Exit 11 (traffic light) onto Crest Haven Road.*
- Follow Crest Haven Road till it ends (approximately eight tenths of a mile) into our Technical School's parking lot. The Tozour building is on the left with parking available directly in front of the building.*
- Enter the Tozour building. The Evening/Continuing Education Office #145 is the second door on the left.*

From South:

- Garden State Parkway North to Exit 11 (Stay in right lane as you approach Exit 11). Make a right turn at Exit 11 onto Crest Haven Road.*
- Follow b & c directions above.*
