- ❖ Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Class size is limited.
- ❖ A waiting list will be established for classes with full enrollments (note: waiting lists are not carried over to the following year).
- ❖ Suggested ages have been determined by the nature of the program along with the instructor's recommendations.
