Dear Ms. Smith,

This report summarizes the results of the September 13 -14, 2021 mercury air monitoring of the Cape May Technical School MAC gym. During the approximate 29-hour continuous monitoring period, the MAC gym HVAC system was functioning in accordance with the following settings:

- Daytime Occupied mode: 6:00AM 9:00PM, Temperature Setpoint: 67°F, Fresh Air Intake: 15%
- Nighttime Unoccupied mode: 900PM 600AM, Temperature Setpoint: 67°F, Fresh Air Intake: 0%

Results

Airborne mercury levels within the MAC gym with the HVAC running in the daytime occupied mode and nighttime unoccupied mode averaged 0.23 to $0.24\mu g/m^3$; lower than NJ Department of Health guideline of $0.8 \mu g/m^3$.

Our next monitoring will be scheduled for December 2021.
